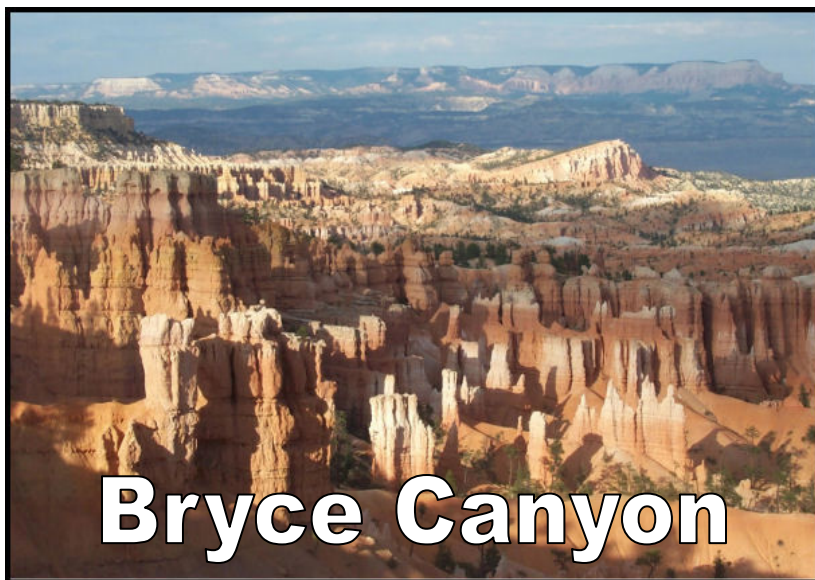


# National Parks Scenic Adventures

## Bryce Canyon

**Mon, April 27**

**Albuquerque, NM**

Everyone will be excited as we board our motorcoach to begin our tour of the National Parks of New Mexico, Arizona and Utah. Enjoy getting acquainted with fellow travelers as we make our way toward Albuquerque.

**Tue, April 28**

**Flagstaff, AZ**

Continuing to the west we will soon be crossing into Arizona where we visit the Painted Desert and Petrified Forest National Park. The 28-mile driving tour offers breathtaking views and brilliant colors due to the presence of iron, copper and manganese. We overnight in Flagstaff, located on the Colorado Plateau under the gaze of the San Francisco Peaks amid ponderosa pine forests, high deserts and lakes.

**Wed, April 29**

**Las Vegas, NV**

Leaving Arizona we cross the Colorado River at Laughlin, NV where we have lunch. The property on which the town is located was purchased by Don Laughlin in 1964. In 1987, he funded and built the Laughlin Bridge connecting Arizona and Nevada at a cost of \$3.5 million. Later we arrive in Las Vegas, home for 2 nights.



**Thu, April 30**

**Las Vegas, NV**

Today is a free day in Las Vegas and there is much to see and do near our hotel located in downtown or you may choose to use the public transportation to visit the strip. There are museums, shows and shopping but do not miss the Fremont Street Experience located right outside our hotel each evening.

**Fri, May 1**

**Bryce Canyon, UT**

Spectacular sights await as we enter Zion National Park, located in southwestern Utah. Zion contains large sculpted rock formations co-existing with waterfalls and a gorge being carved through colored sandstone and shale by the Virgin River. Moving northward we overnight near the entrance of Bryce Canyon.

**Sun, May 3**

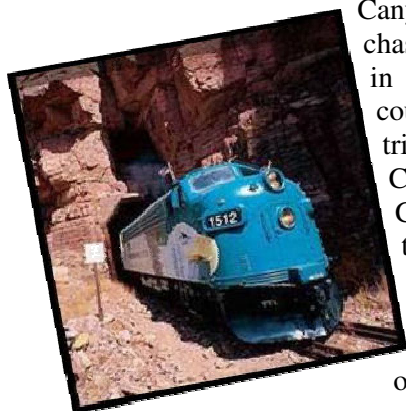
**Flagstaff, AZ**

The highlight of today will be our visit to the south rim of the Grand Canyon, Arizona's most famous attraction and one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Measuring nearly one mile deep, it averages eight miles across and stretches 260 miles in length.

Our scenic drive will take us through Oak Creek Canyon, a breathtaking chasm to Sedona, located in the beautiful red rock country. Enjoy a round-trip ride on the Verde Canyon Railroad from Clarksdale to the ghost town of Perkinsville. Verde Canyon is home to the majestic bald eagle and is accessible only by rail.

**Tue, May 5**

**Albuquerque, NM**

Sit back and enjoy the views of Western New Mexico as we return to Albuquerque for the last night of our tour.
