Fri, Oct 1 Overnight DFW Area

Mon, Oct 4 North Conway, NH

This morning's scenic drive will take us across a small section of New Hampshire and along the coast of Maine with a stop at the Nubble Lighthouse, one of the most photographed lighthouses in the state. Continuing on to Kennebunkport we will have the opportunity of seeing Walker's Point, the summer home of George and Barbara Bush. Returning to the Granite State of New Hampshire, we will overnight in North Conway.

Tue, Oct 5 Burlington, VT

Another great day awaits us as we travel on the

superscenic Kancamagus highway, one of the most scenic byways in the country. As we

journey through the White Mountains we will stop at Franconia Notch State Park. Traveling the back roads into Vermont we will pass through small villages as we are en

route to Montpelier, our nation's smallest capitol. We will visit the Morse Farm to see how Maple Sugaring works from trees to the finished product before continuing to Burlington. With a population of 39,000 it is the largest city in Vermont and our home for the next two nights.

Burlington, VT

Today we travel to Stowe, the ski capital of the East. Thu, Oct 7

Bennington, VT

Start today with a narrated scenic cruise aboard the *Spirit of Ethan Allen* on beautiful Lake Champlain. The lake extends from Canada southward 120 miles and varies from 1/4 mile to 12 miles wide. This afternoon's route will take us through quaint villages as we make our way through the Green Mountains to Bennington where we overnight.

Boston, MA
