


Splendors of the Northwest

July 23 - August 6, 2018
(15 days - 14 nights)



Mon, July 23
Albuquerque, NM
Today will be an exciting day with everyone getting acquainted with fellow travelers as we begin our tour to include New Mexico, Colorado, Utah,

Nevada, California, Oregon, Washington and Idaho with many exciting attractions along the way. This will be a vacation to be remembered forever!

Tue, July 24 **Moab, UT**
Our route will take us through Farmington, NM then north to Cortez, CO. Crossing into Utah we will overnight in Moab whose unique combination of beautiful red rock scenery, two national parks, and the cool waters of the Colorado River has made it one of the most sought after destinations in the southwest.

Wed, July 25 **Salt Lake City, UT**
Begin the day with a driving tour of Arches National Park with photo opportunities of some of the natural sandstone arches that give this park its name. This afternoon we arrive in beautiful Salt Lake City, located at the foot of the Wasatch Mountains. Tonight, enjoy dinner at the Garden Restaurant located on the 10th floor of the Joseph Smith Building giving you a great view of Utah's most popular tourist attraction, Temple Square and home of the six-spired Mormon Temple.

Thu, July 26 **Reno, NV**
Upon leaving Salt Lake City we will have views of the Great Salt Lake, the largest natural lake west of the Mississippi. Shortly, we cross into the state of Nevada, the seventh largest state, yet has one of the smallest populations in the United States. We overnight in Reno, "the Biggest Little City in the World".

Fri, July 27 **Eureka, CA**
Our scenic drive across the Golden State of California takes

us through Susanville, flanked by the cliffs of the Susan River Canyon and Redding, located near Shasta-Trinity National Forest. By evening we will be at the beautiful Pacific Ocean where we overnight in Eureka. Enjoy dinner at the Samoa Cookhouse, the last surviving lumberjack camp-style cookhouse in the West.

Sat, July 28 **Gold Beach, OR**
Heading north along the California coastline we soon enter the Redwood National Park, home to some of the tallest trees in the world. Visit the Trees of Mystery where we will be greeted by a 49-ft. tall Paul Bunyan and Babe the Blue Ox. Enjoy picture taking on the skytrail while riding in a 6-passenger gondola above the Redwood Forest. Continuing northward on Hwy 101 we route along the coast as we enter the beautiful state of Oregon.

Sun, July 29 **Newport, OR**
Enjoy our morning in the small town of Gold Beach, located

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on the Rogue River at the Pacific Ocean. This afternoon we continue along the Pacific Coast to Newport, our home for 2 nights.

Mon, July 30
Newport, OR

Located in Newport is the Oregon Coast Aquarium, a world-class marine educational attraction nestled on beautiful Yaquina Bay. A leisurely afternoon awaits us as we explore this small town of Newport, a tourist destination since the early 1900's.

Tue, July 31 **Hood River, OR**

Visit the Evergreen Aviation Museum in McMinnville with its many exhibits but do not miss its "crown jewel" the Spruce Goose. In Portland, Oregon's largest city, we walk thru the International Rose Test Garden with 7,000 rose bushes. The location provides an awesome view of the city. Nature has endowed Portland with many gifts--majestic mountain vistas, a mild climate and a deep-water harbor. Staying near the water we have 2 nights alongside the Columbia River in Hood River, OR.

Wed, August 1 **Hood River, OR**

Visit the Bonneville Dam, located on the Columbia River, the largest producer of hydroelectric power in America. Spectacular scenery abounds as we view the beautiful Columbia River Gorge from the Crown Point Vista House. Later have your camera ready at the 620-ft Multnomah Falls, the second highest waterfall in the country. Today's route will take us into Washington, located across the river.

Thu, August 2 **Boise, ID**

This morning we continue along the Columbia River and by noon be arriving in Baker City to visit the National Historic Oregon Trail Interpretive Center. The story of the journey of the men, women and children who walked 2,000 miles comes alive through life-sized exhibits.

Fri, August 3 **Salt Lake City, UT**

Leaving Boise, Idaho's capital city we route to Twin Falls to see the 1500 ft. bridge over the Snake River, 486 ft. below. Continuing across the lower edge of Idaho, we return to Utah, the Beehive State.

Sat, August 4 **Moab, UT**

On our driving tour of Utah Olympic Park we will learn about the 2002 Olympics and view the highest Nordic ski jump in the world before some free time in Park City.

Sun, August 5 **Albuquerque, NM**
Returning to New Mexico we re-route through Farmington and to Albuquerque for the final night of our tour.

Mon, August 6 **Home**
We begin the last day of our journey with memories of our tour whirling in our minds. We will long remember the new friends we have made and the great places we have visited on our tour to the spectacular northwestern United States.
