#### Tuesday, April 9 Ponca City, OK

#### Thursday, April 11 St. Louis, MO

Today we venture on to St. Louis but first stop for lunch at Blue Owl Restaurant, made famous by their "Levee High Caramel Apple Pie!" This afternoon you will stand in the shadow of the world's tallest arch, the centerpiece of the Gateway Arch National Park that completed its \$350 million makeover in July 2018. Explore the museum, watch the award-winning film *Monument To The Dream*, that documents the

Today we enjoy a full day of exploration in the city known as the "Gateway to the West." St. Louis, built along the western bank of the Mississippi River, marks Missouri's border with Illinois. Joined by our local guide, we start our day with a city tour. From the iconic skyline to riverboats, Clydesdale horses to laser lights, we quickly learn there is something for everyone as we take in all that St. Louis has to offer.

#### Saturday, April 13 Hayti, MO

We say goodbye to St. Louis with anticipation of more adventures ahead. Step back in time as we board the 92-year old passenger cars on the St. Louis, Iron Mountain and Southern Railway, initially established to deliver iron ore from Iron Mountain to St. Louis. Hold on to your purses and wallets as there might be some shady characters hanging around.

#### Sunday, April 14 Texarkana, TX

This morning YOU decide! You have two options for your morning activities. The first option is to fill your morning at Elvis Presley's *Graceland*. There you will have full admission to the mansion tour, the airplanes, cars, costumes and plethora of memorabilia and exhibits. Lunch is on your own at the entertainment complex. Your second option is **Bass Pro Shop at the Pyramid.** This megastore includes hunting, fishing, camping and related outdoor recreation merchandise as well as a bowling alley, archery range and an outdoor observation deck. Lunch and admission to observation deck are included in this option.
