**Wed, Oct 2**  
**Tulsa, OK**

Today we begin our fall

tour to include Niagara Falls and many other attractions in the northeast. Enjoy meeting fellow travelers as we make our way northward to our overnight destination of Tulsa, OK.

**Thu, Oct 3**

**Effingham, IL**

After a restful night we continue through Oklahoma and into the "Show Me" state of Missouri which was home to Mark Twain and Walt Disney, as well as Harry Truman. By late afternoon we will cross the mighty Mississippi River at St. Louis and overnight in Effingham, IL.

**Fri, Oct 4**

**Columbus, OH**

We drive across Indiana and into Ohio where we stop in Dayton at the United States Air Force Museum, the largest and oldest military aviation museum in the world. Annually over 1 million visitors from around the world tour the facility featuring 300 aircraft and missiles and thousands of artifacts.

**Sat, Oct 5**

**Niagara Falls, ON**

Today we route around Cleveland, through Pennsylvania, New York and cross into Niagara Falls, Ontario, our home for 2 nights. Tonight's dinner will be atop the Skylon Tower where we will have a great view of the falls.

**Sun, Oct 6**

**Niagara Falls, ON**

We begin the day with a tour of the area and a visit to the beautiful town of Niagara-on-the-Lake. Look for a photo opp at the Floral Clock, one of the world's largest floral clocks, with its 19,000 blooming plants. This afternoon we board the *Hornblower* for an "up-close" look as our boat passes directly in front of the falls.

**Mon, Oct 7**

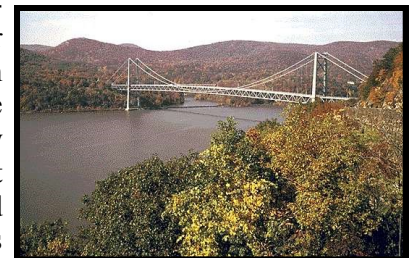
**Middletown, NY**

**Lancaster, PA**

**Fri, Oct 11**

**Morehead, KY**

A beautiful drive awaits us today as we head west across the panhandle of Maryland and into West Virginia., aptly named the "Mountain State" We overnight tonight in the "Bluegrass State" of Kentucky.

**Sat, Oct 12**

**Nashville, TN**

Enjoy the views as we pass through the tobacco fields and horse ranches of Kentucky. This afternoon we continue to Nashville, and an evening of fun at CabaRay's, Nashville's newest "must see" attraction featuring the music and comedy of Ray Stevens.

**Texarkana, TX**

Heading west across Tennessee, we will again cross the Mississippi River, this time in Memphis. We route
