Dickens on The Strand began with a mission....to save The Strand's historic buildings from demolition. A group of Galvestonians, along with Galveston Historical Foundation (GHF), understood the historical significance of the endangered structures and took action. In December of 1974, a potluck

supper was organized on The Strand to gain public awareness about the potential destruction of what is now a National Historic Landmark District. Today the event is the single largest fundraising event for GHF to continue its efforts to preserve and revitalize the heritage of Galveston Island.

Galveston, TX


Begin the day with a tour of Galveston and learn the history of the city and how it has recovered from the 1900 Hurricane and Hurricane Ike in 2008. Galveston is the home of several of the state's largest teaching hospitals, and the Passenger Cruise Ship Terminal at the Port of Galveston greatly helps the economy of the island. Get ready for the Dickens on the Strand Queen's Parade this afternoon! Her Majesty will be escorted by a colorful guard of Beefeaters, in her own royal parade greeting her subjects from an elegant horse-drawn carriage. Also, in the procession through historic Galveston are bagpipe bands, a host of costumed characters, choirs and Victorian attired ladies and gentlemen, on foot and riding in decorated carriages. This evening we feast on a Holiday buffet at Moody Gardens before walking the Festival of Lights Trail. See dozens of lighted displays such as Santa's Workshop, a Gingerbread House and the Nativity.
