Anticipating the mild days and cool nights of Ruidoso we board our motorcoach, meet our fellow travelers and route toward the “Land of Enchantment”. The mountain resort town of Ruidoso lies in the rugged Sierra Blanca mountain range where it merges with the Sacramento Mountains to the south. Ruidoso has been experiencing explosive growth and currently, is the 4th fastest growing city in New Mexico, after Albuquerque, Rio Rancho and Las Cruces. Upon arriving in Ruidoso, we will check in to the Inn of the Mountain Gods Resort and Casino. The premier resort and casino is located near Ruidoso, in Mescalero, and is owned by the Mescalero Apache Tribe. This will be our home for 3 nights. This evening we will go to the nearby Flying J Ranch for a Chuckwagon Supper and Western Show. For over 30 years the Wranglers have been taking audiences back to the Old West with fantastic fiddling, banjo plunking, guitar picking, world-champion yodeling and amazing harmonizing as they sing western ballads telling stories about the great American cowboys of old.

Having been in operation since 1982, the Flying J is known for great food and excellent family entertainment.

After enjoying a good night’s rest, we board our motor coach and route through picturesque Cloudcroft to Alamogordo where we stop at the Eagle Ranch Pistachio Farm. We will view the Pistachio trees and learn about how they are grown and harvested. Inside we will see the machinery needed to get them ready for packaging. Eagle Ranch Pistachio Farm has been in business since 1974 and opened Heart of the Desert Vineyards in 2002. We will have the opportunity to sample and shop in their retail store. Ruidoso Downs hosts both Thoroughbred and Quarter Horse racing, notably the All American Futurity, the richest race in Quarter Horse racing. It also hosts the Grade 1 All American Derby in early September, which carries a purse of \$1,900,000 and was won in 2014 by the New Mexico-bred gelding, Too Flash For You. This evening you will have free time to explore the many activities available at the Inn of the Mountain Gods and have dinner on your own.
