Thu, Aug 22
Tulsa, OK

Everyone will be excited as we board our motorcoach to begin our tour of America's Colorful

Fri, Aug 23 **Effingham, IL**

Sat, Aug 24 **Columbus, OH**

We have scheduled a visit at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway, the most-visited attraction in the state. The 500-Mile Race was first held in 1911 as it has been ever since with the exception of the war years, 1917-18 and 1942-45. The Hall of Fame Museum also appeals to more than just the racing enthusiast as several examples of early antique and classic passenger cars are displayed along with priceless memorabilia.

Sun, Aug 25 **Lancaster, PA**

Today we continue eastward across Ohio and into Pennsylvania, "The Keystone State" that was once the keystone or middle of the 13 original colonies. Late afternoon we arrive in Lancaster, the heart of the Amish Country, and enjoy a smorgasbord dinner.

The flag flown over the star-shaped Fort McHenry during the Battle of Baltimore, September 13-14, 1814, inspired Francis Scott Key to write "The Star-Spangled Banner." Afterwards, we will enjoy lunch at Harborplace, which overlooks the Inner

Annapolis, MD

Sat, Aug 31

Nashville, TN

We begin today with a visit to the Andrew Johnson National Historic Site. Johnson, our 17th president, was known as a "courageous commoner" as he was the first president who had neither been a military hero nor studied law. Today's drive will have us skirting the Great Smoky Mountains as we continue to Nashville. This evening we will enjoy Nashville's newest "Must See" entertainment attraction, the Ray Stevens CabaRay dinner show! Ray Stevens will be live on stage with his fabulous band and backup singers, performing his many hits. You will laugh out loud and it will be an experience you will remember forever.


