Fri, June 11 Tulsa, OK

It is always exciting to board the motorcoach, meet new travelers and depart on the tour we have been anticipating for months. We route northward to Wichita Falls where we stop for lunch before continuing into Oklahoma. By late afternoon we will be arriving in Tulsa, where we spend our first night.

Sat, June 12 Springfield, IL

This afternoon we continue to Milwaukee, our home for 2 nights.

A staff of naturalists at the center will share the biology, ecology and natural history of bald and golden eagles. This afternoon we will continue to Bloomington, our home for a 2-night stay.

Wichita, KS

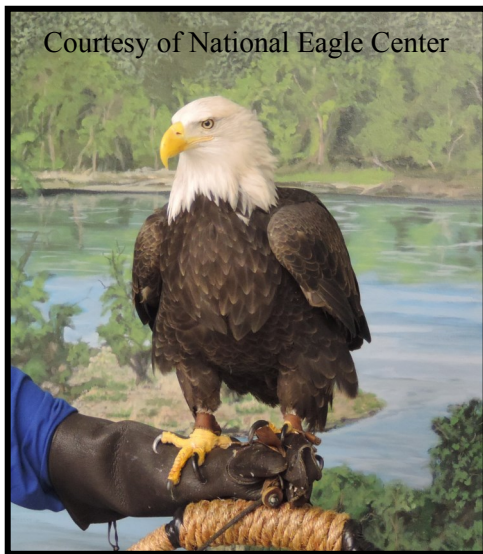
