Wed, Aug 17 Warwick, RI

We transfer to DFW Airport to board our flight to Boston and begin our tour of Cape Cod and More! Our chartered motorcoach will be

waiting to transfer us to Warwick, Rhode Island, a suburb of Providence. Rhode Island is the smallest of the 50 United States and was the first colony to declare independence from Britain and the last to ratify the Constitution, holding out until the Bill of Rights was added.

Warwick, RI

We take the short drive to Connecticut and spend the day in the village of Mystic. Historically, a leading seaport of the area, the story of Mystic's nautical connection is told at Mystic Seaport, the nation's largest maritime museum. The *Charles W Morgan*, built in 1841, is the last wooden whaleship in the world and has been permanently berthed at Mystic Seaport since 1941.

Fri, Aug 19

Hyannis, MA

Today we travel to Newport, which in the 1800's was a resort where the rich and famous came to vacation. A local guide will conduct a tour of the area including the famed Ocean Drive and the Bellevue Avenue mansion area. We will tour The Breakers, a Vanderbilt mansion constructed

between 1893 and 1895 as the summer home of Cornelius Vanderbilt II. The 150 ft. x 120 ft. dimensions of the five-story mansion are aligned symmetrically around a Great Hall. Next, we route to our hotel in Hyannis where you can unpack and enjoy the next 4 nights.

We continue our tour of Cape Cod with a ferry ride to "The Storybook Island" of Martha's Vineyard. This resort combines the best of today with the charm of yesterday. On our narrated tour you will learn about the history and lifestyle of the islanders

as we travel through its small villages. Lunch and shopping time are allowed in the historic whaling village of Edgartown. Complete your day on the island in Oak Bluffs. You may choose to stroll through "Cottage City" with its brightly painted cottages and decorative "gingerbread" trim. We will ferry back to the mainland for an included dinner this evening at the charming Optimist Café. Originally, the Captain Howes House, this beautiful historic home was built in 1849 by Captain Frederick Howes.

Sun, Aug 21

Today we will enjoy a full day of touring as we travel historic Route 6A, the Old King's Highway, a scenic byway winding through centuries of Cape Cod history. It winds past hundreds of historic structures which characterize its early development. Continuing down cape we will drive through the Cape Cod National Seashore with a view of the lighthouse and to Provincetown, located at the tip of the cape - the "Land's End." We will enjoy the wonderful variety of restaurants, shops, and galleries in the "Province Lands" area of Cape Cod before we tour the Hyannis area including the John F Kennedy Memorial, the Korean War Memorial, Hyannis port and a view of St. Francis Xavier Church, the summer parish of the Kennedy Family.

We will again board a ferry, this time taking us to Nantucket where we have a narrated tour of this picturesque island. Enjoy the unique charm of the cobblestone streets with its many shops and boutiques. The island is a popular destination for romantic weddings.
