The state's premier foliage route glows with color —bronze, gold russet, punctuated with the rich purple of gum trees, scarlet of sugar maples and sumac and deep green pines. Joining us on our journey will be a Park Interpreter for Queen Wilhelmina State Park to insure we do not miss a thing.

by enjoying the local flavor of Mena, AR.
