Tuesday, June 27

Texarkana, AR

With our toes tapping and a favorite tune running through our head, we set out to celebrate some of Country Music's legacy families as we set our sights on Tennessee. We enjoy lunch in the DFW area before routing east across Texas. We cross over into Arkansas for our overnight stay in Texarkana.

Wednesday, June 28

Union City, TN

We continue our journey into N. Little Rock where we will enjoy a tour of the Edgemont House, a private palatial garden estate and restored 1927 home of Chris H. Olsen. Dine at the Edgemont House before making our way to North East Arkansas. We will stop and visit the Historic Dyess Colony: established in 1934 as federal agricultural resettlement community under the WPA. Here we will also find the Johnny Cash Boyhood home and Heritage Site. Crossing in Tennessee, our overnight stay is in Union City, TN.

Thursday, June 29

Clarksville, TN

This morning we uncover the mystery behind Reelfoot Lake State Park as we take a morning scenic boat excursion. While still in Union City, we also explore Discovery Park of America; a 1000,000 sq ft museum highlighting science, space, technology, the military, natural history, and more as well as a 50-acre heritage park. After lunch, we continue on to Clarksville, TX, our home for the next two nights.

Friday, June 30

Clarksville, TN

Start the morning with some toe tapping Bluegrass at brunch featuring Clarksville local band, Passenger Creek. This morning's banjo player is the great grandson of Opry legend, Uncle Dave Macon. This afternoon we head south to Bon Aqua to visit the Storyteller Museum before making our way to the hallowed ground of the Johnny Cash Hideaway Farm. Johnny called this the "center of his universe." Enjoy a country

dinner served in the farmyard, followed by a special concert under the stars by those closest to Country Music greats. Hilary Williams (Hank Williams Sr's granddaughter) and Mark Alan Cash (nephew of Johnny Cash) will sing, tell stories and share insights into life growing up around these legends.

Saturday, July 1

Jackson, TN

This morning we enjoy some time in Clarksville's Downtown Market before heading to Historic Collinsville, a living history Pioneer settlement in rural Montgomery County. We will learn about life in the 1800-1900s before sitting down to a Southern Fried Gospel Luncheon Show. It promises to be a finger-lickin,' hand-clapping good time. Afterwards we make our way to Loretta Lynn's Ranch in Hurricane Mills, TN. Tonight's entertainment will feature Loretta's granddaughter, Tayla Lynn. She is joined by the grandson of Loretta Lynn's dear friend, Conway Twitty. Together they will thrill the crowd with stories about their legendary families and beautiful music. The concert is to be followed by fireworks.

Sunday, July 2

Texarkana, TX

As we turn west, we make our way to Memphis, TN, located on the Mississippi River. Our visit to the National Civil Rights Museum at the Lorraine Motel, a Smithsonian Affiliate museum, will surely move you as you reflect on stories that changed our nation. The museum is built around the former Lorraine Motel, which was the site of the assassination of Martin Luther King, Jr in 1968. Lunch is just across the way at Memphis's award-winning barbecue restaurant, Central BBQ. Tonight we will rest once again in the Lone Star State.

Monday, July 3

We will be bringing home with us many memories of our time together and music in our heart as we celebrated the legends of Country Music through the help of their families and friends.
