Sat, June 17

Amarillo, TX

Denver, CO

This morning we visit Colorado Springs's newest treasure, the US Olympic and Paralympic Museum. Selected as the country's Best New Attraction by USA TODAY in 2020, the museum boasts 12 galleries and lots of great artifacts including the Olympic torches and

medals throughout modern times. Explore, learn, and relive great Olympic moments. After lunch we make our way to Colorado's capital, Denver. With the help of our step-on guide, we explore the Mile-High City before checking into our hotel for the evening.

Wed, June 21

Glenwood Springs, CO

All aboard! We board our Rocky Mountaineer train for a breathtaking journey along the Colorado River and across the Continental Divide. Home to five official mountains over 14,000 feet in elevation, the Colorado Rockies will provide a backdrop to some breathtaking views throughout our day. After a day on the train, we will overnight in the quaint town of Glenwood Springs, CO at a local hotel. Enjoy your evening with a stroll about town or even a dip at their world-famous hot springs.

Thurs, June 22

Moab, UT

We are in store for another beautiful day aboard the Rocky Mountaineer on our westward route to the 45th state, Utah. Get your cameras ready as we take in some of the most colorful rock formations boasting hues of

red, orange, yellow, brown, and maroon. These stunning rocks attract visitors from all over the world. Utah's "Red Rock Country" is created by simply one element –iron. As we leave behind our train, we settle in for the next two nights amongst the beauty of the red rocks. The finishing touch of a perfect day will be on a slow-moving evening board ride on the Colorado River.

Fri, June 23

Moab, UT

Begin the day with a driving tour of Arches National Park with photo opportunities of some of the 2,000 natural stone arches, hundreds of soaring pinnacles, and massive rock fins, and giant balanced rocks. No wonder the park is named Arches. Continue the afternoon exploring Canyonlands National Park knowns for its dramatic desert landscape carved by the Colorado River .

Sat, June 24

Durango, CO

Heading to the southeast, our first stop will be Mesa Verde National Park, created in 1906 to protect some of the best-preserved cliff dwellings in the world. Our visit will afford you great photo opportunities and a better understanding of the Ancestral Pueblo people who once lived in this area. After lunch with make our way into Durango where this evening's entertainment will be at the Bar D Chuckwagon Supper and Old West Cowboy Music Show.

Sun, June 25

Taos, NM

Today we take a break for our motorcoach and board the Cumbres & Toltec Scenic Railroad. This moving National Historic Landmark, at 64-miles in length, is the longest, the highest and most authentic steam railroad in North America. You will travel through some of the most spectacular scenery in the Rocky Mountain West. Owned by the states of Colorado and New Mexico, the train crosses state borders 11 times.

Mon, June 26

Amarillo, TX

We begin our homeward journey leaving behind the Sangre de Cristo Mountains of Taos, New Mexico and set our sights upon the Lone Star State. After lunch, we cross back into our familiar Central Standard Time zone and overnight in Amarillo.
