

Alaska's Northern Lights

March 4* - 10, 2024
(7 days - 6 nights)



Mon, Mar 4 ***overnight in DFW Area**

This afternoon we board our motorcoach in Abilene and route to the DFW area to overnight in anticipation for tomorrow's flight to Fairbanks, Alaska.

Tue, Mar 5 **Fairbanks, AK**

After breakfast, we transfer to DFW Airport for our flight to Alaska, where we are off to explore the majesty of our 49th state. Arriving in Fairbanks, we will settle in for the next three nights in search of the dancing, dazzling display in the sky known as the aurora borealis.

Wed, Mar 6 **Fairbanks, AK**

With the help of a guide, we learn about the vibrant river city in the far north where locals embrace the natural world around them. After lunch on your own, we step back into an amazing time in history to see a world-class collection of vintage automobiles and period fashions at the Fountainhead Antique Automobile Museum. Annually Fairbanks hosts the World Ice Art Championship, where the finest sculptors from around the world compete in the most challenging ice sculpting competition. Today we enjoy the finished carvings on display at the Tanana Valley Fairgrounds. At 65 degrees north latitude, the sky takes on a capricious life of its own—a canvas for the aurora borealis. Tonight we venture outside of the city lights in hopes for our first glimpse of the Northern Lights.

Thu, Mar 7 **Fairbanks, AK**

This morning will be an experience like none other as we join a lifelong Alaskan on a walk with her furry friends at Running Reindeer Ranch. This immersive

walk along side the reindeer will help us discover why reindeer are ideal for Arctic living. Next we stop at the University of Alaska—Fairbanks to visit the Museum of the North, the only research and teaching museum in Alaska. The museum's research collection is comprised of 2.5 million artifacts and specimens collected on public lands in Alaska. Enjoy the afternoon and evening at your leisure. Carve out an Alaska memory that is perfect for you; perhaps that is dog sledding or ice fishing, or hop a flight and fly around the Artic Circle. Whatever you choose, this memory will last a lifetime.

Fri, Mar 8 **Chena Hot Springs Resort**

After lunch we discover the place every child has dreamed...the North Pole! Known for its year-round Christmas decorations, including candy cane-striped street lights, we stop at Santa Claus House where the walls are covered in children's letters to Santa. Surely you will want a selfie with the huge Santa statue outside. Afterwards we make our way to Chena Hot Springs Resort, where we will enjoy a two

Located under the most active band of northern lights, it is away from the light pollution of city lights. For your viewing pleasure tonight, Chena Hot Springs Resort provides a special “aurora wake up call” for guests staying since most aurora “shows” are more visible from 10pm—3am.
