

Fri, July 12 Raton, NM

Today will be an exciting day with everyone getting acquainted with fellow travelers as we begin our tour featuring some of the most iconic national parks and events of the West.

Sat, July 13 Boulder, CO

Suspended 956 feet over the Arkansas River, the Royal Gorge Bridge is the perfect first stop of the day. Walk the 1257 wooden planks across the bridge or take the aerial gondola, either ensures the perfect view. We will enjoy lunch at Royal Gorge before continuing on to Boulder for the evening.

Sun, July 14 Laramie, WY

Just about an hour away from Boulder, we arrive in Estes Park, CO; known as a "scenic wonder road of the world," we will take in the beauty of Rocky Mountain National Park's highway to the sky, traversing 48 miles atop the ridges and mountaintops of Northern Colorado. *Altitude 14,259'* Later this afternoon, we will cross from Colorado to Wyoming.

Mon, July 15 Flagg Ranch

Heading northwest of Laramie, we visit Wind River Wild Horse Sanctuary. The Oldham family provides care in a free-roaming environment for over 225 wild mustangs. This is 1 of 4 Public Off-Range pastures, in partnership with the BLM in the United States. By evening, we step back in time and embrace the beauty of our surroundings for the next two nights at Flagg Ranch; located at the south

Tue, July 16
Known as the mountains of the imagination, today we take in the majestic views of approximately 310,000 acres that comprise Grand Teton National Park. Have those cameras charged and ready for some awesome photos ops. Enjoy some free time this afternoon in Jackson Hole before enjoying our BBQ dinner at the Bar T 5 Chuckwagon Dinner & Show.

Wed, July 17 Cody, WY

Today is the day! Encompassing around 3,5000 square miles, we set our sights on Yellowstone National Park. From Old Faithful and the geyser

Thu, July 18 Gillette, WY

After a night's rest, we spend our morning at Buffalo Bill's Center of the West; home to five world-class museums including the Cody Firearms Museum and the Whitney Western Art Museum. This afternoon our routing takes us through the Bighorn Mountains, a sister range of the Rocky Mountains.

Fri, July 19 Laramie, WY

Nestled in the foothills of the Big Horn Mountains, we visit the picturesque town of Buffalo. We will enjoy lunch at the Historic Occidental Hotel. Undoubtedly, Butch Cassidy walked its streets. Buffalo is also home to New York Times Bestselling Author, Craig Johnson; author of Longmire mystery novels (now made into a tv series.) We complete the loop of Wyoming, arriving back in Laramie for a two-night stay.

Sat, July 20 Laramie, WY

This morning we kick off the day with a curbside seat for the 128th Cheyenne Frontier Day Grand Parade downtown Cheyenne. The "Daddy of 'em all" has been kicking up dust since 1897 and continues to be the world's largest outdoor rodeo and western celebration. Afterward this morning's parade, we make our way to Old Frontier Town for browsing, shopping, and lunch on your own before taking your seat for this afternoon's PRCA Pro Rodeo.

Sun, July 21 Colorado Springs, CO

With one my glimpse of the "Daddy of 'em all", we take the Behind the Chutes tour to get a first-hand look at what goes on during the rodeo from behind the scenes and even walking across the arena for the perfect photo op. Just seven miles from Cheyenne, we stop at Terry Bison Ranch; home to approximately 2500 head of American Bison. After a beef or bison lunch, we will take the bison train tour around the ranch before making our way back into Colorado for the evening.

Mon, July 22 Amarillo, TX

Today we travel south across colorful Colorado, briefly through the Land of Enchantment before entering Central Standard Time zone at the Lone Star State border. We will overnight in Amarillo.

Tue, July 23 Return home

As we are getting closer to home we will be reminded of all the spectacular sights we have seen, great places we have visited, memories we have made and our new friends who we will never forget and "That's WY" this tour was a bucket list trip for many.
