Mon, July 19

Kamloops

Onboard Rocky Mountaineer, embark on an awe-inspiring rail journey as you travel through some of the world's most majestic scenery. Beyond your sparkling glass window, enjoy views of coastal deep-green forests, roaring river canyons, and snowcapped mountain peaks. From Vancouver, B.C. to Banff, Alberta, let the Rocky Mountaineer bring you on a spectacular voyage through the verdant farmlands of the Fraser Valley and the towering peaks of the Coast Mountains. Inside your single-level dome coach, gaze out at the stunning panoramas of the mighty Fraser River and the raging white waters of Hell's Gate. Watch the landscape transform again, this time to a semi-arid desert, as you travel toward the city of Kamloops for your overnight stay in a hotel.

Tue, July 20

Banff

Continue east this morning to the spectacular Canadian Rocky Mountains. History comes alive as you travel this legendary rail route that united Canada as a nation, through the century-old Spiral Tunnels and along the powerful Kicking Horse River. Traverse the Continental Divide and keep an eye out for moose,

elk, and bighorn sheep – not to mention osprey, soaring eagles, even the occasional bear. After another beautiful day onboard Rocky Mountaineer, raise a glass for a final toast. Arrive this evening in the mountain village of Banff, nestled in the heart of the majestic Canadian Rockies. Here we will stay for two nights.

Wed, July 21

Banff

This morning, we set out to explore the breathtaking beauty of Banff National Park on a guided sightseeing adventure through the heart of the Canadian Rockies. We will enjoy photo stops at the powerful Bow Falls and the famous Surprise Corner, where stunning panoramic views of Banff and the surrounding peaks create picture-perfect memories. We continue with a visit to the Cave and Basin National Historic Site, the birthplace of Canada's national parks and the location where the story of this remarkable conservation movement began. Afterwards we will return to charming downtown Banff for lunch on your own and leisurely free time. Browse unique shops, relax, or take a peaceful stroll along the riverside while soaking in the unforgettable mountain scenery that makes Banff such a treasured destination.

Thu, July 22

Lake Louise

A wonderful day of sightseeing awaits as we set out along the unforgettable Icefields Parkway. Marvel at impressive waterfalls, rushing rivers, glacial peaks, imposing cliffs and the picture-perfect snowcapped mountain ranges. At the Athabasca Glacier, take a fun ride aboard a Snowcoach Ice Explorer across this 1,000 feet thick mass of glacial ice – the largest accumulation of ice south of the Arctic Circle and also have the opportunity to take a walk on the Glacier Skywalk to experience the breathtaking views of the Sunwapta Valley and witness the dramatic landscape from the glass-floored platform. Our breathtaking drive to Lake Louise provides us with time to admire emerald waters and glacier-capped mountains.

Fri, July 23

Calgary

Enjoy a morning of leisure to soak up the mountain air before departing on a scenic drive along the Bow Valley admiring the stunning landscape. Be on the
